

TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE

ORDINANCE NO. 12-360

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE ARIZONA, AMENDING TOWN CODE CHAPTER 17.108, SIGN REGULATIONS, AS IT RELATES TO POLITICAL SIGNS.

WHEREAS, the Town wishes to amend the Pinetop-Lakeside Town Code Chapter 17.108, Section 17.108.060(A)(9) to make the Town Code consistent with changes made to A.R.S. §16-1019 by the Legislature in 2011 in Session Law Chapter 318 (HB 2500).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, ARIZONA, as follows:

Section 1:

Town Code Section 17.108.060(A)(9) Political Signs, is amended as follows:

17.108.060 Signs not requiring a permit.

A. No sign permit shall be required for the following types of signs:

9. Political Signs. Political signs of not more than ~~twenty-four (24)~~ SIXTEEN (16) square feet ON RESIDENTIAL LOTS AND THIRTY-TWO (32) SQUARE FEET ON NON-RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES are permitted during an election campaign, provided, that campaign signs are not posted more than ~~forty-five (45)~~ SIXTY (60) days preceding the election and are removed within ~~five (5)~~ FIFTEEN (15) days following the election. Political signs may be freestanding or wall-mounted to a building, or fence mounted. Roof-mounted signs are not permitted. Political signs may not be affixed to utility poles or traffic signs and shall not in any way present a traffic hazard or vision obstruction, ~~and shall not be located in the public right-of-way.~~

Section 2:

This Ordinance will become effective on the 1st day of April 2012 and it is the intent of Town Council that its Code be interpreted and applied in accordance with the laws and Constitutions of the State of Arizona and the United States of America.
