

**TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE**

**ORDINANCE NO. 12-362**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, ARIZONA, ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO TOWN CODE CHAPTER 8.04 "FIRE RESTRICTIONS/OUTDOOR BURNING", SECTION 8.04.010 "GUIDELINES", SUBSECTION C.**

**WHEREAS**, following consultation with neighboring jurisdictions (U.S. Forest Service, Navajo County, City of Show Low, and local fire districts), and upon recommendation of Town staff, the Mayor and Town Council assent to staff recommendation in order to maintain the Town's participation with other area jurisdictions in the development of consistent laws and regulations as cooperating jurisdictions during emergency fire conditions.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Arizona, as follows:

**Amending Section 8.04.010(C)** by omitting the reference to "Zone K", and changing the fire restriction ERC reading from sixty-five (65) to eighty (80), to read as follows:

C. The Town's Emergency Management Director will utilize the U.S. Forest Service ("U.S.F.S."), Apache-Sitgreaves ~~Zone K~~ Energy Release Components ("ERC") Monitoring System to help determine when fire restrictions may be necessary. As a general guideline, when the ERC reading reaches ~~sixty-five~~ **EIGHTY (6580)**, fire restrictions should be considered.
