

TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE

RESOLUTION NO. 19-1513

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, ARIZONA, PERTAINING TO THE SUBMISSION OF A PROJECT FOR CONSIDERATION UNDER THE TOHONO O'ODHAM NATION, PROPOSITION 202, 2019 TWELVE PERCENT GAMING DISTRIBUTION GRANT.

WHEREAS, the passage of Proposition 202 by the voters of Arizona in November 2002 set the stage for new gaming compacts between the State and the respective tribes. An important provision of Proposition 202 was the sharing of gaming revenues with the State. A portion of the revenue to be shared can be retained by a tribe and distributed itself. Specifically, Proposition 202 states:

“The Tribe shall make twelve percent (12%) of its total annual contribution under Section 12(B) in either or both of the following forms:

- 1) Distributions to cities, towns, or counties for government services that benefit the general public, including public safety, mitigation of the impacts of gaming, or promotion of commerce and economic development.
- 2) Deposits to the Commerce and Economic Development Commission Local Communities Fund established by A.R.S. Section 41-1505.12.”

The Tohono O’odham Nation is currently receiving application for programs and projects that focus on education, public safety, health, environment, and economic and community development. As such, the Tohono O’odham Nation, has chosen to distribute 12% payments directly to local governments and non-profit organizations; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, through the Pinetop-Lakeside Police Department, is interested in submitting a project to be considered for funding in the form of a 100% reimbursable grant through the Tohono O’odham Nation for FY 2019 ARS 5-601-02 twelve percent (12%) Gaming Distribution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Arizona as follows:

1. THAT approval of the submission of a project for consideration through the Tohono O’odham Nation for FY 2019 ARS 5-601-02 twelve percent (12%) Gaming Distribution, is granted.
2. THAT the Chief of Police is appointed agent and/or his designee, for the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents and any other necessary or desirable instruments in connection with such grant, and assign in-kind resources.
