RESOLUTION NO. 19-1518

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, ARIZONA, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Town experienced an unusually severe storm system the evening of August 1, 2019, and the damages resulting therefrom, may cause personal harm to individuals and may cause the extensive destruction of private property and to the many public facilities, streets and roads within the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside; and

WHEREAS, the flooding could result in a condition of extreme peril to the health and safety of many citizens; and

WHEREAS, A.R.S. § 26-311 authorizes the Mayor of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Arizona or his/her designee to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that I, Stephanie Irwin, Mayor of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Navajo County, Arizona, declare that an emergency exists pursuant to Chapter 8.04 of the Pinetop-Lakeside Town Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that during the existence of said emergency, local government agencies assigned emergency roles in the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside Emergency Plan constitute an Emergency Organization and the Pinetop-Lakeside Emergency Plan is hereby activated and in effect until further notice.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the immediate operation of the provisions of this Resolution is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside.


