

TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE

RESOLUTION NO. 20-1565

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, ARIZONA, PERTAINING TO THE SUBMISSION OF GRANT PROJECT FOR CONSIDERATION UNDER THE GILA RIVER INDIAN COMMUNITY, PROPOSITION 202, 2020 TWELVE PERCENT GAMING DISTRIBUTION GRANT.

WHEREAS, the passage of Proposition 202 by the voters of Arizona in November 2002 set the stage for new gaming compacts between the State and the respective tribes. The Gila River Indian Community gaming revenues are being used to improve the health and well-being of tribal members, strengthen public safety, open up educational opportunities, and address a multitude of other needs.

Under Proposition 202, Arizona Tribes also agreed to share a portion of their revenues with the State of Arizona. Of the revenues shared, twelve percent is made available to cities, towns, or counties for the purpose of benefiting the general public through either direct distribution to the local governments or in the form of a deposit to the State of Arizona Commerce and Economic Development Commission's Local Community Fund.

For its 2020 revenue sharing, the Gila River Indian Community has chosen to contribute directly to local governments. Therefore, the Gila River Indian Community is seeking Requests for Funding Proposals from Arizona cities, towns, counties, and non-profit organizations; and

WHEREAS, the Pinetop-Lakeside Police Department has submitting a project related to public safety for the purchase of ten (10) new mobile data computers. The funding is in the form of direct grant funding via the Gila River Indian Community, Proposition 202, 2020 Twelve Percent Gaming Distribution Grant. Notification has been received from the Gila River Indian Community, advising this project is recommended for approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Arizona as follows:

1. THAT approval of this project through the Gila River Indian Community, Proposition 202, 2020 Twelve Percent Gaming Distribution Grant is granted.
2. THAT the Chief of Police is appointed agent and/or his designee, for the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, to conduct all negotiations and to execute and submit all documents and any other necessary or desirable instruments in connection with such grant.
