RESOLUTION NO. 14-1319

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF PINETOP-LAKESIDE, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE WOODLAND LAKE PARK ACCESS ROADS MAINTENANCE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Eastern Arizona Regional Advisory Committee (RAC) members approved US Department of Agriculture Forest Service funding for the Woodland Lake Park Access Roads Maintenance Project (Project) based on the federal requirements, guidelines and project readiness; and

WHEREAS, the Project funding will complete resurfacing within the traveled roadway, as well as the treatment of an established parking area at Woodland Lake Park; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside was awarded \$45,000 (partial funding) to complete the highest priority roadway deemed to be the north side access road and associated parking area; and

WHEREAS, the Eastern Arizona RAC Committee requested a supporting resolution to Resolution No. 14-1309, adopted May 1, 2014 to authorize the Town's designees to execute documents deemed necessary to advance and complete the Woodland Lake Park Access Roads Maintenance Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Pinetop-Lakeside, Arizona, hereby authorize the Mayor and/or Town Manager to execute any and all documents necessary to complete Eastern Arizona Resource Advisory Committee Grant utilizing US Department of Agriculture Forest Service Secure Rural Schools and Communities Self-Determination funds.
